SUBJECT: ASSIGNMENT OF APPLICATIONS FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENTS

Pursuant to rule 10.603(c)(1)(D) of the California Rules of Court, in civil cases where all defendants are in default, applications for court default judgments under Code of Civil Procedures section 585 are assigned to Hon. Victoria Kolakowski (or other designee, at the discretion of the Supervising Judge of Civil) for review, disposition, and/or prove-up or other hearings, notwithstanding the previous assignment of the case to a judge for all purposes. A judge assigned to a civil case for all purposes may, however, exercise their discretion to retain an application for court default judgment.

This directive shall expire on December 31, 2020.
