OR: Recent Payment Activity Notice / Receipt

If you checked box 2. (b), - Gross household income is less than listed in the Family Size chart -, on your Ability to Pay application, please provide copies of:

Current pay warrant with Year-to-Date totals:

OR: If Year to Date totals not on pay warrant, submit copies of prior 3 months pay warrants

If married, must also provide proof of income of spouse same as above

If dependents, must also provide copy of most recent Tax Returns

If you checked box 2. (c), on your application, please provide copies of the following documentation:

Current pay warrant with Year-to-Date totals

OR: If Year to Date totals not on pay warrant, submit copies of prior 3 months pay warrants

If married, must also provide proof of income of spouse same as above

If dependents, must also provide Copy of most recent Tax Returns

Copy of current bank statement(s)

Copy of rental agreement or recent mortgage statement

Copy of current statements for any expenses you want taken into consideration to demonstrate your inability to pay
