This Addendum No. 1 is issued for the Parolee Reentry Court Program – Treatment Service Provider RFP No SC 010/008 which was issued on Thursday, September 2, 2010.

Questions and Answers:

Q1: Is there a page or word length prescribed for the narrative or any other section of the proposals?

A1: There is no page limit for the proposal

Q2: Is there an allocation for each of the separate services for which proposals are being requested?

A2: There is no allocation for services at this time. Services will be based upon the number of participants admitted to the program. See: RFP No. 010/008 pages 36 – 38 for an estimated number of participants in the program.

Q3: Will there be more than one award made in each category, or will that depend on the amount and quality of the proposals received?

A3: There will be only one award for each RFP.

Q4: Licensing and certification requirements for individual clinicians are provided, but is there a minimum requirement for certification of the program where services will take place? And along with that, will there be a preference for programs that are dually-certified as substance abuse treatment and mental health treatment providers?

A4: There is no minimum requirement for certification of a program. It is expected that the service provider will have experience providing substance abuse and mental health treatment. Programs that are dually-certified demonstrate that experience.

Q5: Has the case management provider already been selected? It was mentioned in the project overview but nowhere else in the RFP.

A5: The case managers have been hired at the Superior Court and will work with the community based agency providing mental health and substance abuse counseling.

Q6: Is the RFP strictly for group counseling, or is it expected that there will be individual counseling as well, which is needed to do treatment planning or assessment?
