GENERAL ORDER RELEASING
NAMED PERSONS FROM SANTA RITA
COUNTY JAIL DUE TO COVID-19
PANDEMIC

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING and upon request by the Alameda County District Attorney, the Public Defender, and the Alameda County Defense Bar, the Court orders the immediate, early or “own recognizance” release of the individuals listed in the attached spreadsheet, “Attachment D”. These individuals have been deemed “vulnerable” due to health or age concerns or are otherwise considered appropriate for early release.

Two have been sentenced and, in spite of their early release, their sentences will be deemed served. Their release is ordered forthwith.

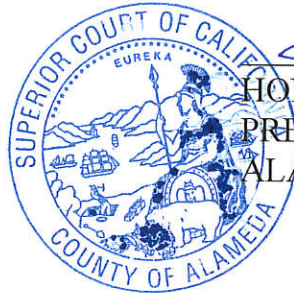
One has been sentenced, and the sentence is being “split.” That individual is ordered released forthwith and will receive credit for the time served in custody to this date. That individual is further ordered to be of good conduct and obey all laws and to appear on Tuesday, July 7, 2020, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 712 of the East County Hall of Justice, 5151 Gleason Drive, Dublin, CA. At that time, the individual will be ordered to serve the sentence remainder from out-of-custody.

The Court issues this order in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the proclamations of states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, the Alameda County Public Health Officer’s March 16, 2020

shelter-in-place order, Executive Orders N-33-20 and N-38-20, issued by Governor Newsom on March 19 and 27, 2020, respectively, the Advisory on COVID-19 and Court Operations issued by Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye on March 20, 2020, the March 22, 2020 Major Disaster Declaration for California by President Trump, and the Statewide Orders issued by Chief Justice Cantil-Sakauye on March 23, 2020 and March 30, 2020.

It is SO ORDERED.
