**SUBJECT: DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO SUPERVISING
JUDGE, CIVIL DIRECT CALENDARING, TO
ASSIGN CASES**

Pursuant to Rule 10.603(d) of the California Rules of Court, the presiding judge delegates to the supervising judge of civil direct calendaring the authority to reassign or direct the reassignment of cases between civil trial judges as the result of:

- (1) The disqualification of a judge pursuant to sections 170.1 through 170.6 of the Code of Civil Procedure; or
- (2) An order declaring cases related pursuant to Rule 3.300 of the California Rules of Court.

This directive shall expire on December 31, 2013.
