**DIRECTIVE NO: 2014-17**  
**SUBJECT: MOTIONS FOR DNA TESTING PURSUANT  
TO PENAL CODE SECTION 1405**

All motions under Penal Code section 1405 shall be filed with the criminal division of the clerk's office at the René C. Davidson Courthouse. Motions presented for filing at other locations shall be forwarded to the René C. Davidson County Courthouse for filing, together with the case file.

Immediately after filing, the motion shall be forwarded with the case file to the Master Criminal Calendar Judge in Department 11 for review to determine whether it complies with the requirements set forth in subdivision (a) of Penal Code section 1405. If the motion satisfies the requirements of that section, the Master Criminal Calendar Judge will assign the matter to another judge for further proceedings pursuant to the section. The motion will be assigned to the judge who conducted the trial, if available.

This directive shall expire on December 31, 2014.
