
DIRECTIVE NO: 2015-16
**SUBJECT: GRAND JURY REQUESTS TO INTERVIEW
COURT MEMBERS OR EMPLOYEES IN CIVIL
INVESTIGATIONS**

In order to enable the Court to exercise its supervisory responsibility regarding the grand jury's civil investigatory authority:

1. It is ordered that if the grand jury desires to interview any member or employee of the court, the foreperson of the grand jury shall address to the presiding judge a sealed written request for the interview of a specified member or employee of the Court that identifies the interviewing grand jurors and specifies all questions to be put to the member or employee of the Court.
2. If any of the interrogatories regard matters beyond the civil investigatory authority of the grand jury then the presiding judge may summon the grand jury to Department One and so charge them.
3. If any of the interrogatories regard matters within the civil investigatory authority of the grand jury then the presiding judge shall assist the grand jury in obtaining the information or interviewing the appropriate member or employee of the Court.
4. This general directive does not govern any grand jury investigation into criminal conduct.

This directive shall expire on December 31, 2015.
