Chapter 2. Criminal Rules

Rule 4.115 – Emergency Rule Adopting Temporary Emergency Bail Schedule

During the COVID-19 crisis, and as authorized by the Chairperson of the Judicial Council, the Uniform Bail Schedule is suspended and the following emergency bail schedule is adopted:

- (1) Infractions - \$0.00.
- (2) Misdemeanor offenses - \$5,000.00 for any misdemeanor offense enumerated in Penal Code section 1270.1; \$0.00 for all other misdemeanor offenses.
- (3) Felony offenses - \$0.00 for a felony offense carrying a maximum sentence of 4 years or less in state prison, unless the conduct alleged qualifies as an enhancement under the law. In such cases, bail shall be set at the enhancement bail amount provided for in the Uniform Bail Schedule in effect. The Uniform Bail Schedule in effect remains in full force and effect for all other felony offenses.
- (4) Misdemeanor probation violations - \$500.00.
- (5) Felony probation violations - \$5,000.00.
- (6) Post Release Community Supervision violations - \$5,000.00.
- (7) Parole Violations - 5,000.00.
