Chapter 1. General and Administrative Rules

Rule 1.10a. Emergency rule for juror questionnaires

(a) Mandatory questionnaire

Each prospective juror must complete questionnaires for identification, qualification, ability to serve, assistance in the voir dire process, and fair population representation.

(b) Hardship questionnaire

Any prospective juror requesting to be excused from jury service because of undue hardship must complete a hardship questionnaire.

(c) Remote submission of questionnaires

Prospective jurors should complete and submit all questionnaires through the Court's web site or jury web portal, the addresses of which are included in the jury summons. Questionnaires completed through the web address must be submitted no later than 4:00 p.m. on the Tuesday prior to the date the juror has been summoned to appear in court. If responses are not submitted through the internet the prospective juror must appear in person in court to complete the questionnaires on their jury summons date.

(d) Confidentiality

The responses to questionnaires will remain confidential to all but the attorneys and judge in the trial and will be destroyed if the prospective juror is not assigned to a trial.
