GENERAL ORDER RELEASING
NAMED PERSONS FROM SANTA RITA
COUNTY JAIL DUE TO COVID-19
PANDEMIC

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING and upon request by the Alameda County District Attorney, the Public Defender, and the Alameda County Defense Bar, the Court orders the immediate, early or “own recognizance” release of the individuals listed in the attached spreadsheet, “Attachment B”. These individuals have been deemed “vulnerable” due to health or age concerns.

Five have been sentenced and, in spite of their early release, their sentences will be deemed served. Their release is ordered forthwith.

Three are pending final disposition of their cases. They are released on their own recognizance and are ordered to be of good conduct and obey all laws. They are further ordered to appear on Monday, May 18, 2020, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 11 of the Rene C. Davidson Courthouse, 1225 Fallon Street, Oakland.

The Court issues this order in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the proclamations of a states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, the Alameda County Public Health Officer’s March 16, 2020 shelter-in-place order, and Executive Order N-33-20, issued by Governor Newsom on March 19, 2020.

It is SO ORDERED.
