GENERAL ORDER RELEASING
NAMED PERSON FROM SANTA RITA
COUNTY JAIL DUE TO COVID-19
PANDEMIC

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING and upon request by the Alameda County District Attorney, the Public Defender, and the Alameda County Defense Bar, the Court orders the immediate, early or “own recognizance” release of the individual listed in the attached spreadsheet, “Attachment C”. This individual has been deemed “vulnerable” due to health or age concerns. This individual has been sentenced and, in spite of the early release, the sentence will be deemed served. The release is ordered forthwith.

The Court issues this order in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the proclamations of states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, the Alameda County Public Health Officer’s March 16, 2020 shelter-in-place order, Executive Order N-33-20, issued by Governor Newsom on March 19, 2020, the Advisory on COVID-19 and Court Operations issued by Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye on March 20, 2020, the March 22, 2020 Major Disaster Declaration for California by President Trump, and the Statewide Order issued by Chief Justice Cantil-Sakauye on March 23, 2020.

It is SO ORDERED.
