


Traffic Amnesty Program

You might be eligible for a **reduction of 50% or 80%**, and to have your driver's license reinstated.

To qualify for a reduction of the amount owed, all of the following conditions must be met:

- ✓ You have an outstanding traffic case that was due to be paid in full before January 1, 2013.
- ✓ The last date you made a payment was on or before June 24, 2015.
- ✓ You don't owe restitution to a victim on any case in the county where the traffic case was filed.
- ✓ You have no outstanding misdemeanor or felony warrants in the county where the traffic case was filed.



If you are currently making payments you may be eligible to have your driver's license reinstated, although you won't be eligible for a reduction in the amount owed.

NOT ELIGIBLE: Parking tickets or violations for driving under the influence (DUI) or reckless driving.

Program runs from October 1, 2015, through March 31, 2017
