



Alameda County Superior Court Juror Hardship Request

Under the laws of California, the Court will consider excusals for undue hardship only for a limited number of serious circumstances, which are:

1. Risk to you or others of harm due to physical or mental disability or impairment.
2. You have no reasonably available means of public or private transportation to court.
3. Travel to court involves an excessive distance ("excessive" means more than one and one-half hours each way, from your home to the court).
4. Extreme financial burden (to you personally, not your company).
5. Risk of material injury or destruction to your property or property entrusted to you.
6. Your services are needed for the protection of the public health or safety; alternative arrangements are not feasible.
7. You are the sole and indispensable caretaker of another person.
8. You are a full-time day student who will lose credit if absent (i.e., you cannot make up the class).
9. You have pre-paid, non-refundable vacation plans within the next 4 to 6 weeks (specify the dates of travel below).
10. You completed jury service within the last 12 months.

If any of these categories apply to you, you must fill out the declaration below, under penalty of perjury. The declaration must include all the details necessary to justify the excusal. Please attach relevant documentation to this form.
