USE OF SUBORDINATE JUDICIAL OFFICERS AND

TEMPORARY JUDGES TO REVIEW AND ADJUDICATE

EX PARTE MATTERS

The Court may utilize subordinate judicial officers and/or temporary judges to review and adjudicate certain ex parte matters, including but not limited to the following:

- Applications for Civil Harassment temporary restraining orders;
- Applications for Domestic Violence temporary restraining orders;
- Applications for Elder Abuse temporary restraining orders;
- Applications for Workplace Violence temporary restraining orders;
- Applications for Gun Violence temporary restraining orders;
- Requests for Entry of Default Judgement in Unlawful Detainer and/or Collections matters;
- Applications to Serve Summons by Posting in Unlawful Detainer matters;
- Requests for stays in Unlawful Detainer matters;
- Applications for Order of Publication; and
- Requests to Waive Court Fees.

This directive shall expire on December 31, 2024.
