The current pandemic of the novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) has resulted in the President of the United States declaring a national emergency and the Governor of California and Alameda County issuing shelter-in-place orders that apply to this jurisdiction.

Existing guidance from the national, state, and local public health authorities recommend social distancing of at least six feet between persons and limits gatherings to no more than 10 persons, among other preventative practices.

You have the right to a public and speedy trial within 45 days of your arraignment or plea. Please note that the Judicial Council has granted the Court authority to extend this time limit up to an additional 60 days pursuant to the Statewide Emergency Order issued on March 30, 2020 by the Hon. Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chief Justice of California and Chair of the Judicial Council. This means that your case must be dismissed if you are not brought to trial within this time limit, unless you give up your right to a speedy trial. However, if you do give up your right to a speedy trial, that will allow the court more flexibility in setting a trial date.

By signing this form below, you acknowledge that you understand the above-listed rights, and that you are giving up your right to a speedy trial and consenting to have your Court Trial in the above-referenced case continued to the next available date.
