ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT ANNOUNCES WALK-IN TRAFFIC COURT AT FREMONT HALL OF JUSTICE

Fremont – Alameda County residents will have the option of quickly resolving traffic tickets in Fremont thanks to the creation of a new Walk-in Traffic calendar at the Fremont Hall of Justice on October 2, 2007.

Without the Fremont Walk-in Traffic Court, residents in Fremont, Newark, Union City and the unincorporated areas of Washington Township must travel to courthouses in other communities to take advantage of walk-in services. Now South County residents can resolve tickets closer to home in a single day, as can commuters who work in or near Fremont.

"This program is consistent with the walk-in services currently offered in Hayward, Pleasanton and Oakland," Lynette Norcup, Trial Court Administrator for Pleasanton and Fremont said.

The court will conduct hearings on Tuesday and Thursday mornings beginning at 9 a.m. Space is limited, and cases will be heard on a first come, first serve basis. The courthouse will open at 8:00 a.m.

Creation of the Fremont Walk-in Traffic Court is part of an ongoing effort by the court to standardize and increase the level of service and efficiency throughout its locations.
