Petition for Change of Name, Recognition of Change of Gender and Sex Identifier

Who can submit Petitions for Name Change in Juvenile Court:

- A minor with a guardian who is appointed by the Juvenile court
- A minor with a court appointed dependency attorney appointed as guardian
- A minor who is alleged or adjudged to be a ward of the court
- A non-minor dependent
- An attorney acting for a minor under Welfare and Institution code sections 601 or 602

What are the options to submit Petitions for Name Change in the Juvenile Court:

Petitions may be submitted in any one of the following options:

- In person at the Juvenile Justice Center <u>Click here for Court address</u>
- United States Mail Click here for Court address
- Drop box <u>Click here for Court address & drop box</u> hours

For the last three options, provide one original, and two copies of the required documents. If you request endorsed copies returned via US Mail, include a self-addressed stamped envelope along with your request.

Do not place Juvenile case number on the petition, instead submit CM015 Notice of Related Case along with your request.
