To determine if you qualify for assistance, the first step is to check the chart below.

For whom are you seeking authority?	Type of Case	Can we assist at the workshop?
Person under the age of 18	Guardianship of the Minor	Yes
Person with Developmental Disability that originated before they turned 18	Limited Conservatorship (can petition before they turn 18 with authority to begin at age 18)	Yes
Adult who is gravely disabled by mental health issues or chronic alcohol use	LPS Conservatorship – must be initiated by public official	No
Adult with a major neurocognitive disorder (e.g. dementia) or susceptible to undue influence	Conservatorship	No
