Requirements for each Pretrial Level

- **Release On Own Recognizance:** Alameda County Probation-Pretrial Services- court reminder only (No reporting requirement)
- **Pretrial Monitoring:** Court reminders and criminal history check (No reporting requirement)
- **Pretrial Supervision Level I:** Court reminders, criminal history check, required in-person contact once per month to Probation/Pretrial Services and special conditions compliance verification
- **Pretrial Supervision Level II:** Court reminders, criminal history check, in-person contact every other week with Probation/Pretrial Services, and special conditions compliance verification
- **Pretrial Supervision Level III:** Court reminders, criminal history check, weekly contact with Probation/Pretrial Services with minimum in person every other week and special conditions compliance verification
- **Defendants ordered on house arrest or electronic monitoring must be placed on Pretrial Supervision Level I, II, or III**

Defendant ordered to be of good conduct, obey all laws, and comply with the following conditions of release:

If released on Level I, II, or III the Defendant must call Probation/Pretrial Services within 24 hours of release between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday. If released on a Friday, the Defendant must call or report the following Monday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. If Monday is a court holiday, the Defendant must call or report the following Tuesday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

If the Defendant does not have access to a phone, they must report in person to one of the locations below.

Defendant ordered on House Arrest or Electronic Monitoring must report in person to Alameda County Probation Department/Pretrial Services within 24 hours of release Monday-Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. If released on a Friday, the Defendant must report the following Monday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. If Monday is a court holiday, the Defendant must report the following Tuesday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Obey the rules and regulations of Alameda Probation Department, Pretrial Services (**Applies to all Defendants released on Level I, II, or III**)

Reside at the following address:

House Arrest

You are ordered confined to the residence listed above and must have **pre-approval** authorized by the Alameda County Probation Department-Pretrial Services to leave this residence a minimum of one business day prior to need. Approvals of movement will be limited and associated with court appearances, employment, education, or medical appointments/treatment programs. This movement is subject to verification. You will be allowed one 3-hour block of time per week to allow for errands of essential needs and religious services. The time and day for this 3-hour block must be approved by Probation/Pretrial Services. As part of the House Arrest, you will be fitted with an electronic monitoring device that will report your location 24/7 to Probation/Pretrial Services. You are ordered to comply with Probation/ Pretrial Services rules on the use of electronic monitoring, including keeping the battery charged.

Electronic Monitoring

You will be fitted with an electronic monitoring device that will report your location 24/7 to Probation/Pretrial Services. You are ordered to comply with Probation/ Pretrial Services rules on the use of electronic monitoring, including keeping the battery charged.

Four-way search and seizure – Submit to search and seizure by any Probation/Pretrial Services officer or any other law enforcement office at any time of the day or night, with or without search warrant: vehicle, residence, person, or any property under your control.

Five-way search and seizure - Submit to search and seizure by any Probation/Pretrial Services officer or any other law enforcement office at any time of the day or night, with or without a search warrant: vehicle, residence, person, or any property under your control to include all electronic devices, and supply passwords upon request.

Must have no contact with minors without adult supervision
