Chapter 1. General Provisions

Proposed Local Rule 5.26. Deferred Status Conference Pending Collaborative Law Process, Private Mediation, or Court Appointed Private Judge.

If the parties to a case for dissolution of marriage, nullity, or legal separation elect to resolve the case using the collaborative law process, private mediation, or court-appointed private judge, they may file a stipulation and proposed order to defer a status conference using *Stipulation and Order to Defer Status Conference* (ALA-FL056). If the collaborative law process or private mediation is unsuccessful, or the appointment of private judge is terminated, a party may request a status conference using *Request for Status Conference* (ALA-FL057).
