Notification pursuant to California Rules of Court Rule 10.620 "Public access to administrative decisions of the trial court":

The Superior Court of California, County of Alameda (the Court) plans to make the following budget modifications effective January 23, 2015:

- 1. Increase the budget for information technology hardware for implementation of the Court's Odyssey Case Management System by \$650,000. This is the Court's FY14-15 investment in Odyssey. The Court committed \$4,300,000 to the Odyssey Case Management System in FY13-14. Additional FY14-15 funds are needed to support the full purchase price of the system; when fully implemented, Odyssey will replace obsolete case management systems for Criminal, Juvenile, Civil, Family Law, and Probate.
- 2. Transfer budget amounts with a net neutral impact between Court Programs to correct original budget assignments:
 - \$1,003,802 Fiscal Services
 - (\$613,800) Traffic and Other Infractions
 - 5512,800 Criminal
 - o (\$437,002) Information Technology
 - o (\$400,000) Security
 - o (\$93,000) Civil
 - o \$23,200 Jury Services
 - o \$10,000 Human Resources
 - (\$10,000) Court Interpreters
 - \$4,000 Judges and Courtroom Support
 - \$3,000 Executive Office
 - o (\$3,000) Juvenile Delinquency Services
 - o \$2,500 Probate, Guardianship
 - (\$2,500) Business and Facilities Services
