PUBLIC ACCESS TO COURTROOM PROCEEDINGS

With limited exceptions, all court proceedings are being conducted remotely via video or telephone conference during the COVID-19 pandemic.

- ❖ For in-person proceedings, social distancing generally requires that physical courtroom access be limited to Court personnel, parties, counsel, witnesses, and jurors.
- ❖ All non-confidential, on-the-record proceedings may be accessed through the Court's livestream audio system at <http://www.alameda.courts.ca.gov/Pages.aspx/Live-Stream>.
- ❖ Members of the media may also request permission to attend court proceedings via remote video or in person. See [emergency Local Rule 1.7a\(d\)](#) for details.
- ❖ Court records may be accessed through the following methods:
 - Public civil records are available online through DomainWeb at <https://publicrecords.alameda.courts.ca.gov/prs>.
 - Criminal calendars and register of actions are available online through the Odyssey portal at <https://publicportal.alameda.courts.ca.gov/publicportal>.
 - Records that cannot be made available remotely per [rule 2.503](#) of the California Rules of Court may be accessed from public records terminals at the René C. Davidson Courthouse, 1225 Fallon Street, Oakland, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
